

VEHCLE SET UP DECOMMENDATONS

Vehicle Set Up Recommendations

Vehicle inspection: Complete a vehicle inspection before heading off. Include; fuel, oil, lights, belts, brakes, exhaust is not loose and a general look around the car.

Check tyres: Properly inflated tyres will provide better traction and handling. Ensure your tyres are not damaged and have no objects embedded in them and your wheel nuts are secure.

Engage 4WD: Shift the vehicle into 4WD mode before heading off-road.

Lock differentials: If your vehicle has a differential lock, engage it for maximum traction.

Adjust driving speed: Slow down and drive carefully on rough terrain.

Know your vehicle's clearance: Be aware of your vehicle's height and approach angles to avoid damage.

Carry recovery gear: Bring a tow strap, and other recovery gear in case you get stuck. If you have a winch ensure the hook and/or shackle are correctly secured

Battery: Ensure your battery is firmly secure

Respect nature: Stay on designated trails to avoid damaging the environment. Do not enter camp sites unless you have an approved booking.

Seat belts: Drivers and Passengers are required to wear a seat belt at all times
