



FIRE PIT POLICY

Fire Pit Use Policy

Welcome to our fire pit! To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all our guests, please follow these guidelines when using the fire pit:

1. Only use the fire pit supplied by the property. No other open fires are permitted on the premises.
2. Do not use the fire pit on days when there is a fire ban or in high winds. Please check local fire regulations and weather conditions before starting a fire.
3. The fire must be attended at all times by a responsible adult who is familiar with fire safety practices.
4. Prior to retiring for the night or leaving the fire pit area, make sure the fire is completely extinguished. To extinguish the fire, pour water over the embers until there is no more steam or hissing. If water is not available, use sand or dirt to smother the fire. Do not leave the fire unattended.
5. Have a sufficient supply of water or a fire extinguisher nearby at all times in case of emergency.
6. Do not burn any hazardous materials, including but not limited to, trash, plastics, chemicals, or treated wood.
7. Keep a safe distance from the fire pit and never lean over it. Do not throw anything into the fire pit.
8. Children must be supervised at all times and kept a safe distance from the fire pit.
9. Be considerate of other guests and keep noise levels down, especially after dark.
10. Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in the immediate termination of your stay without refund.
11. By using the fire pit, you agree to abide by these guidelines and assume all liability for any damage or injury that may result from your use of the fire pit.
